PROJECT START-UP & COMMUNICATION

The development of project specific materials and documents has been completed – this includes a poster for participants, a onepage information sheet for service providers and a schedule for training sessions.

CULTURAL SENSITIVITY TRAINING

The GBV team provided cultural sensitivity training to five external partners.

Family Services of Ottawa facilitated Around the Rainbow training for Inuuqatigiit staff members. The GBV team also attended two conferences in Montreal (More than Words and Inuit Studies).



PARTICIPANT SEARCH

The GBV team is currently seeking participants with lived experience of gender based violence to participate in this project. We are looking for input, knowledge and expertise to validate our Inuit specific model of service delivery.

Note: Participants must either be involved with Inuuqatigiit or referred to our services.

Components of an Inuit-Specific Wrap-Around Model:

By addressing family, mental & physical health, childcare, housing, culture and language, this strengths-based approach reduces barriers for individuals and families, builds capacity and contributes to better outcomes for Inuit women, men and youth affected by gender-based violence.

Data Tracking and Project Evaluation

Starting early in the new year, Inuuqatigiit's internal front-line staff and the five community partners involved in the project will begin tracking data that will help test and evaluate the Wrap-Around Model.

Project evaluation will begin in the new year - NVision has been hired as our external evaluater and has prepared an evaluation plan.



A second meeting will be held early in the New Year! Stay tuned - invites will be sent out late January 2020.

Advisory Committee meetings will then be held on a quarterly basis.
